The Newberry County Voter Registration and Elections Board met Monday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. at the election office. Temporary Chairman Henry Summer called the meeting to order and opened with prayer.

Board members present were Scott Cain, Brenda Fulmer, John Glasgow, Doretha Simpson, Henry Summer and Martha Waller. Also present were Director Sheli Madray and Deputy Director Danial Piester.

A quorum was established with all six board members present.

Scott Cain made the motion to approve the agenda. John Glasgow seconded. The agenda was adopted with no changes.

Doretha Simpson made the motion to approve the minutes of the October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025, board meeting. Scott Cain seconded. The minutes were approved as presented.

Under old business, Director Madray reported that the office is still looking for a replacement location for the Newberry City Ward 4 precinct. Director Madray has left messages with no responses. Brenda Fulmer will contact a friend who attends St. Mark's Catholic Church.

Deputy Director Piester has completed all ADA upgrades for the November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Municipal Elections. Orange Cones for parking have been loaned to the office.

Newberry County approved additional compensation for poll workers effectively for the 2026 elections. Poll managers will receive an additional \$60.00 with poll clerks receiving \$70.00.

There will be a special election on December 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025, for Silverstreet mayor and one council seat. Election certification will occur on Friday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026, at 10:00 am at the election office. Candidate filing is Friday, November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025, through November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at noon.

Under new business, the Municipal elections for Little Mountain, Prosperity and Newberry are Tuesday, November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Board members received a list of the precincts involved and were assigned precincts to cover and a new layout for election night duties including clerk return checklists as election materials are returned to the office.

There is the possibility of a runoff in the Town of Prosperity for town council and a special election for town council.

MaKinley Richardson, a second grader at Pomaria Garmany Elementary School, was the winner of the "I Voted" sticker contest. Stickers were available for board members. MaKinley will ride in the Newberry Christmas Parade on Saturday, November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025. The parade is from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm. A metal sign of her design has been printed for the parade.

The 49<sup>th</sup> Annual SCARE Conference is January 27- 30, 2026 in Myrtle Beach, SC. Funds are available for the office staff and two board members to attend. The conference agenda was available for board members.

Review of the election board by-laws was postponed until 2026.

There being no further business, John Glasgow made the motion to adjourn. Brenda Fulmer seconded. The motion was approved. The meeting adjourned at 1:45 pm. The next scheduled board meeting will be Tuesday, December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 1:00 pm.
