

PUBLIC NOTICE OF CANDIDATE FILING AND SPECIAL ELECTION

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA - COUNTY OF NEWBERRY - TOWN OF SILVERSTREET

Candidate Filing Period: A special candidate filing period for the Town of Silverstreet Mayor and 1 Council seat will open at noon on Friday, November 7th, 2025, and close at noon on Friday, November 14th, 2025.

Filing Form: The Statement of Intention of Candidacy form required for filing is available in the “Candidate Information” section of scVOTES.gov and at the county voter registration and elections office.

Filing Fee: There are no filing fees for these offices.

State Ethics Filings: Candidates are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests and a Campaign Disclosure online with the State Ethics Commission at <http://ethics.sc.gov>. Failure to file these documents may result in a candidate fine but will not disqualify a candidate from the election. Contact the State Ethics Commission for more information.

Notice of Election: This special election will be held on Tuesday, December 30th, 2025. Any person wishing to vote in this election must be registered by Sunday, November 30th, 2025. The Early Voting period for this election begins on Monday, December 15th, 2025, and ends on Friday, December 26th, 2025. The following early voting center will be open during the early voting period from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (**Excluding Christmas Eve and Christmas Day and the day after Christmas, December 24th, 25th & 26th, 2025**): Newberry County Voter Registration & Elections Office, 1872 Wilson Road, Newberry, 803-321-2121.

At 7:00 a.m. on Sunday, December 28th, 2025, the County Board of Voter Registration and Elections will begin its examination of the absentee ballot return envelopes at the County Voter Registration & Election Office located at 1872 Wilson Rd, Newberry (803)321-2121.

On Friday, January 2nd, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. the Newberry County Board of Canvassers will hold a hearing to determine the validity of all provisional ballots cast in the election. These hearings will be held at the County Voter Registration & Election Office located at 1872 Wilson Rd, Newberry (803)321-2121.
