SECTION 01 26 20 WEATHER DELAYS

ARTICLE 1 - GENERAL

1.01 Extension of Contract Time

If a Claim is made for an extension of time based upon weather delays in accordance with the General Conditions, an extension may be granted only for the number of Weather Delay Days in excess of the number of days listed for the applicable month on the Standard Baseline.

2.01 Standard Baseline for Adverse Weather

- A. The Standard Baseline is defined as the number of calendar days for each month during which construction activity exposed to weather conditions is expected to be prevented and suspended by cause of Adverse Weather. Suspension of construction activity for the number of days each month as listed in the Standard Baseline is included in the Work and is not eligible for extension of Contract Time.
- B. The Owner has established a Standard Baseline from the National Climatic Data Center (NCDC) from summary period of 1981 to 2010 and climate record period of 1887 to 2017 for the State of South Carolina.

3.01 Adverse Weather and Weather Delay Days


- A. Adverse Weather is defined as the occurrence of one or more of the following conditions within a twenty-four (24) hour day that prevents construction activity exposed to weather conditions or access to the site:
 - 1. Precipitation (rain, snow, or ice) in excess of one-tenth (0.10") liquid measure.
 - Temperatures that do not rise above that required for the day's construction activity, if such temperature requirement is specified or accepted as standard industry practice.
 - 3. Sustained wind in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour.
 - 4. Dry Out (or Mud) Days under the following conditions:
 - a more precipitation days occur than listed in the Standard Baseline;
 - b there is a hindrance to site access or sitework and Contractor has taken all reasonable accommodations to avoid such hindrance; and,
 - c no more than one (1) Dry Out Day is allocated for each additional day of precipitation more than the Standard Baseline that total 1.0 inch or more, liquid measure, unless specifically recommended by the Designer.
- B. A Weather Delay Day may be counted if Adverse Weather prevents work on the project for fifty percent (50%) or more of the contractor's scheduled work day and critical path construction activities were included in the day's schedule, including a weekend day or holiday if Contractor has scheduled construction activities that day.


C. Days of normal weather conditions which the contractor elects not to perform construction activities will be deducted from the eligible weather delays requested.





- E. Submit in accordance with the requirements of the Contract Documents.



noted the project was a beginning for the City of Newberry to centralize recreation and looked forward to work on the project. A sign-in sheet was distributed and Mr. Whaley noted that today's pre-bid meeting was non-mandatory, but that the sign-in sheet would be kept as a record to note the attendees.

Mr. Whaley discussed the scope of the project as denoted in the advertisement explaining the Base Bid and the six (6) alternates. Mr. Whaley noted the baseball appurtenance materials would be removed from the Base Bid as well as from Alternate #5 and a portion of Alternate #3. The baseball fields will be built to subgrade elevation and seeded for temporary stabilization until the additional funding is completed and bid in the fall. Irrigation will be extended to the baseball field area but not within the field areas. These changes will be noted in Addendum No. 1 to follow. The Addendum will also include an alternate for grubbing only with timbering to be completed before the release of the site and an alternate supplier for lighting.


Mr. Whaley noted that the Bid Opening will take place on April 25, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. at 1309 College Street, Newberry, South Carolina in the Courthouse Annex Conference Room. Questions are to be directed to Steve Whaley via email per the instructions to bidders. Questions will be accepted until April 18, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. No questions received via telephone will be accepted. An addendum will be provided to all attending as well as the contractors on the plan holders list and released to the plan rooms/Newberry County's website once all questions have been received. - A: City of Newberry Council will meet May 8, 2018 and Newberry County Countil will meet May 9, 2018. Once approved for awarding, there will be a ten (10)-day protest period before a pre-construction meeting can be scheduled. The anticipated start date is mid-May to early June.
- Q: Sheet C4.1 notes that the park sign is not to be included, but the bid documents include it. Will the sign be included in the bid?
- A: Yes, the sign is to be included. A revised sheet C4.1 will be issued in Addendum No. 1.
- Q: Is the goal of the site to be balanced?
- A: Contractors are to conduct their cut/fill analysis for the unclassified site.
- Q: Since the project is annexed into the City, would Newberry County need to be involved in building permits?
- A: There is no building involved on this project. All other land disturbance and utility permits have been received.
- Q: Who will provide the geotechnical for the project?
- A: Independent testing will be conducted and will be paid by Newberry County.

- A: The flows have been checked; however, nothing has been inspected internally.
