The Newberry County Registration and Elections Board met Friday, January 2, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. at the Newberry County Election Office. Acting Chairman Henry Summer called the meeting to order and opened with a New Year's prayer.

Board members present were Acting Chairman Henry Summer, Scott Cain, John Glasgow, Brenda Fulmer, Doretha Simpson and Martha Waller. Present also were Director Sheli Madray, County Councilman Johnny Mack Scurry and newly elected Silverstreet Mayor Julie Ann Richardson.

A quorum was established with all six board members present.

Director Sheli Madray administered the constitutional oath to the board members who then signed the State of South Carolina, Newberry County Board of Canvassers Members Oath form.

The board convened as the county board of canvassers for the certification of December 30, 2025, Town of Silverstreet Special Election.

The Unofficial Summary Results Report was distributed to each board member. There were no Provisional ballots and no absentee ballots. Five votes were cast for Mayor, and three votes were cast for Town Council. Julie Ann Richardson received all 5 votes cast for Mayor and Lydia Kinard received the 3 votes cast for Town Council. The Post-election Reconciliation, Audit and

Canvass Checklist was completed. Scott Cain made the motion to certify the election results. John Glasgow seconded. The motion was approved.

The swearing in ceremony for Silverstreet will be held Wednesday, January 7, 2026, at 6:00 pm.

There will be an election March 31, 2026, to fill the town council seat formally held by Robert Martin as he was sworn in as Mayor of Prosperity at 2:00 pm on January 2, 2026. Candidate filing will open in February 2026.

There being no further business, Doretha Simpson made the motion to adjourn seconded by Scott Cain. The motion was approved. The meeting adjourned at 10:23 a.m.
