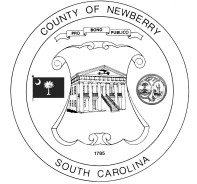

The Newberry County Voter Registration and Elections Board met Monday, April 6, 2026, at 1:00 p.m. at the election office. Chairman Henry Summer called the meeting to order, and John Glasgow opened with prayer.

Board members present were Brenda Fulmer, John Glasgow, Doretha Simpson, Henry Summer and Martha Waller. Also, present was Director Sheli Madray and Deputy Director Danial Piester. Absent was board member Scott Cain.

A quorum was established with five board members present.

Doretha Simpson made the motion to approve the agenda. Martha Waller seconded. The agenda was adopted with no changes.

John Glasgow made the motion to approve the minutes of the March 9, 2026, board meeting. Doretha Simpson seconded. The minutes were approved as presented.

Under old business, Director Madray will email the new By-Laws to board members to be reviewed and approved at the May board meeting

Under new business, there will be a special election runoff in the town of Prosperity for the town council seat previously held by the newly elected Mayor Robert Martin on April 14, 2026, at the Prosperity Depot from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. Early voting runs April 8-10, 2026, at the election office from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm. The runoff is between Terry Murphy and Eric Gallman. Election canvas and certification will occur at 10:00 am on Thursday, April 16, 2026 at the election office.

On April 17, 2026, the State Election Commission (SEC) is offering the Training and Certification Program class Duties of the Board at the SEC office in Columbia. Doretha Simpson expressed interest in attending.

The election office is preparing for the June 9, 2026, Democratic and Republican Primary Election. Director Madray and Deputy Director Piester will be attending the Director Primary Workshop on April 20, 2026, in

Columbia. A few names were suggested to cover the office that day. A Board Primary Workshop is being held April 22, 2026, for board members.

Deputy Director Piester is contacting poll workers for the June 9, 2026, Democratic and Republican Primary Election as clerks and poll workers are still needed.

The 2026 Newberry County Employee Performance Evaluation form for Director Madray was distributed to all board members to review. It was decided to complete the form following the election certification meeting for the Prosperity town council seat runoff on Thursday, April 16, 2026, as it is due April 30, 2026.

The SCARE Midyear Conference is July 22-24, 2026, with arrival on the evening of Tuesday, July 21, 2026, in Charleston, SC.

There being no further business, John Glasgow made the motion to adjourn. Doretha Simpson seconded. The motion was approved. The meeting adjourned at 1:55 pm. The next scheduled board meeting will be Monday, May 4, 2026, at 1:00
