The Newberry County Registration and Elections Board met Thursday, November 6th, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. at the Newberry County Election Office. Acting Chairman Henry Summer called the meeting to order and John Glasgow opened with prayer.

Board members present were Acting Chairman Henry Summer, Scott Cain, John Glasgow, Brenda Fulmer, Doretha Simpson and Martha Waller. Also present were Director Sheli Madray and Deputy Director Danial Piester.

A quorum was established with all six board members present.

Director Sheli Madray administered the constitutional oath to the board members who then signed the State of South Carolina, Newberry County Board of Canvassers Members Oath form.

Scott Cain made the motion that the board convene as the county board of canvassers for the certification of the Municipal Elections for Newberry City Council Seats District 2, District 4 and District 6; Prosperity Town Mayor and 2 Town Council Seats; and Little Mountain Mayor and 2 Town Council Seats held November 4th, 2025. Doretha Simpson seconded. The motion was approved.

The Unofficial Summary Results Report was distributed to each board member. There were two Provisional ballots in the Prosperity Town precinct. Both Provisional ballots were verified for counting by the election staff. Scott Cain made the motion that both provisional ballots be

counted. John Glasgow seconded. The motion was approved. These ballots were scanned through the DS 300 scanner and new totals obtained. The board members reviewed the Post-election Reconciliation, Audit and Canvass Checklist. Doretha Simpson made the motion to certify the election results. Scott Cain seconded. The motion was approved. Board members then signed the Statement and Returns of Votes for Municipal Election Day held November 4th, 2025, form.

Election results were Newberry City Council District 2 – Clay Smith; Newberry City Council District 4 – David T. Force; Newberry City Council District 6 – David DuBose; Prosperity Mayor – Robert Martin; Prosperity Town Council – Mike Hawkins (168 votes) with a run-off required between Kyle Kneece (82 votes) and McKeve Kinard-Shelton (74 votes); Little Mountain Mayor - Jana Jayroe; Little Mountain Town Council - Lane Attaway and Anna Huffstetler both write-ins (no candidates filed for town council) who have accepted the positions. The Prosperity runoff will be held Tuesday, November 18th, 2025, at the Prosperity Town Depot (the precinct location) with early voting at the election office Wednesday, November 12th, 2025, through Friday, November 14th, 2025, from 8:30 am – 5:00 pm.

There will be a special election to fill the town council seat currently held by Robert Martin. WIS has been contacted to cover the Prosperity runoff November 18th, 2025, and the special election for mayor and town council in Silverstreet which is scheduled for Tuesday, December 30th, 2025.

There being no further business, Doretha Simpson made the motion to adjourn seconded by John Glasgow. The motion was approved. The meeting adjourned at 10:32 a.m.
