The quarterly meeting for the Central Midlands LEPC was held at the Newberry County Sheriff's Office Drill Hall 550 Wilson Road, Newberry, SC on October 11, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.

1. The meeting opened with the welcome and introductions by Tommy Long, Newberry County Emergency Management Coordinator.
2. Central Midlands, LEPC By-Laws Review and Voting- Tommy Long- A motion was made, and the By-Laws passed with all in favor.
