Worker's Compensation Update

Newberry County is one of 42 counties that participate in the SC Counties Worker's Compensation Trust. This year Newberry ranks 14 out of the 42 with a lower experience modification score and lower premiums, which indicates a better standing in Worker's Comp claims than in previous years.

5. Discussion of Salary Recommendation for Elected Officials

Mr. Adams stated that Ordinance 8-14-15 set maximum salaries for the County Elected Officials, not including the State Supplement or the annual stipend given to every elected official. That Ordinance also allowed Council to decide if there would be any increases given to the Elected Officials. The second Ordinance 08-15-15 discusses the progression of salaries through a range for newly elected Officials. The committee recommended that the item be pushed to the Finance committee for further discussion.
