Debris Removal and Disposal Services**

The following shall be incorporated into the response for the mentioned solicitation:

Questions were presented:

1. Which landfill does the C&D go to?
The C&D Landfill on SC Hwy 121 may be used, as well as the County Transfer Station on SC Hwy 34
2. Are there any TDSR sites identified?
The County owns twelve convenience sites throughout the County that will be used as temporary sites. The listing is attached.
3. Page 12 says we are to provide a management plan for each category of work describing what actions will be taken for a disaster generating debris in the amount shown below. I do not see amounts shown below.
Remove this section from the solicitation
4. Page 19 asks for out SC Sales Tax Number
This is not required; however, if you conduct business in SC, a business license is a requirement for this solicitation.
5. Page 23 states that we are to acknowledge all addenda on Attachment 1 but there isn't a space for this on Attachment 1.
This Addendum will be signed and returned as acknowledgment
6. Page 18 has incorrect dates; the date for the deadline for submittal is April 30, 2019 at 3:30.
7. Price Proposal Form, Line Item 10, please clarify if this is for open burning or air curtain incineration
This is for controlled open burning
8. Price Proposal Form, Line item 12, please confirm if compaction is the accepted method of reduction C&D
Compaction, grinding and burning will all be methods of reduction

9. Price Proposal Form, Line item 14, please confirm this line item is for hauling reduced C&D debris from the DMS to final disposal site
The price shall be for final destination. If it is hauled to a temporary site, it will be the responsibility of the chosen contractor to haul it to the transfer station for grinding and/or disposal by the vendor.
10. Price Proposal Form, Line item 15, please clarify if this work is to be performed from land (land-based operations) or from the water (marine-based operations)
Newberry County would only be dealing with land-based operations
11. Where does the County currently dispose of its municipal solid waste?
The County has a transfer station, but it is operated by a contractor.
12. Where is the accepted final disposal site for vegetative debris?
The County is the primary site for vegetative debris
13. Where is the accepted final disposal site for C&D debris?
The County transfer station or the C&D landfill
