INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1. Only one copy of bid is required unless otherwise specified.
- 2. Bids, amendments thereto or withdrawal request must be received by the time advertised for bid openings to be timely filed. It is the vendor's sole responsibility to ensure that these documents are received by the purchasing office at the time indicated in the bid document.
- 3. When specifications or descriptive papers are submitted with the bid, enter bidder's name thereon.
- 4. Submit your signed bid on the bidder's schedule provided. Show bid number on envelope as instructed. Newberry County accepts no responsibility for unmarked or improperly marked envelopes.
- 5. Bidders must clearly mark as "Confidential" each part of their bid which they consider to be proprietary information that could be exempt from disclosure under Section 30-4-40 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended, (also known as the Freedom of Information Act). The County reserves the right to determine whether this information should be exempt from disclosure and no legal action may be brought against the County or its agents for its determination in this regard.
- 6. By submission of a bid, you are guaranteeing that all goods and services meet the requirements of the solicitation during the contract period.
- 7. Tie bids will be resolved in accordance with the provisions of the Newberry County Purchasing Ordinance.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1. The County of Newberry reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to cancel a solicitation, and to waive any technicality if deemed to be in the best interest of the County.
- 2. Unit prices will govern over extended prices unless otherwise stated in this bid invitation.
- 3. **PROHIBITION OF GRATUITIES:** South Carolina law and the Newberry County Purchasing Ordinance prohibit the giving of anything of value in return for favors or other preferential treatment in the purchasing process. Bidders should govern themselves accordingly.
- 4. **<u>BIDDERS QUALIFICATION:</u>** Bidders must, upon request of the county, furnish satisfactory evidence of their ability to furnish products or services in accordance with the terms and conditions of these specifications. The County reserves the right to make the final determination as to the bidder's ability to provide the products or services requested herein. Any bidder determined to be an irresponsible bidder will not be allowed to bid to provide the County goods or services requested.

- 5. <u>BIDDERS RESPONSIBILITY:</u> Each bidder shall fully acquaint himself with conditions relating to the scope and restrictions attending the execution of the work under the conditions of this bid. It is expected that this will sometimes require on-site visits and observation. The failure or omission of a bidder to acquaint himself with existing conditions shall in no way relieve him of any obligation with respect to this bid or to the contract.
- 6. **AWARD CRITERIA:** The contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder(s) whose bid meets the requirements and criteria set forth in the Invitation for Bid. Award may be made to one or a multiple of bidders, whichever is deemed to be in the best interest of the County, or unless otherwise stated on the bidder's schedule.
- 7. **WAIVER:** The County reserves the right to waive any Instruction to Bidders, General or Special Provisions, General or Special Conditions, or specifications deviation if deemed to be in the best interest of the County.
- 8. **COMPETITION:** This solicitation is intended to promote competition. If any language, specifications, terms and conditions, or any combination thereof restricts or limits the requirements in this solicitation to a single source, it shall be the responsibility of the interested vendor to notify the Purchasing Director in writing within five (5) days prior to the opening date. The solicitation may or may not be changed but a review of such notification may be made prior to the award.
- 9. **REJECTION:** Ambiguous bids which are uncertain as to terms, delivery, quantity, or compliance with specifications may be rejected or otherwise disregarded if such action is in the best interest of the County.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. **DEFAULT:** In case of default by the contractor, the County reserves the right to purchase any or all items in default in the open market, charging the contractor with any excessive costs. Should such charge be assessed, no subsequent bids of the defaulting contractor will be considered until the assessed charge has been satisfied.
- 2. **NON-APPROPRIATION:** Any contract entered into by the County resulting from this bid invitation shall be subject to cancellation without damages or further obligation when funds are not appropriated or otherwise made available to support continuation of performance in a subsequent fiscal period or appropriated year.
- 3. HOLD HARMLESS AND INSURANCE: The successful bidder shall indemnify and hold harmless the County of Newberry and all County officers, agents and employees against all suits or claims for personal injury or property damage resulting from, or arising from, the successful bidder's performance of the contract, as well as against any suits or claims of any character brought against the County or its agents or employees by reason of any claim of infringement of any patent, trade mark, trade dress, or copyright, including reimbursement to the County for all attorney's fees and court costs incurred by the County in defending itself or its agents or employees against any such claim or suit. In addition, the successful bidder will maintain a public liability policy with at least two million dollars \$2,000,000 single limit, for damages arising from acts which occur during the contract period, with the County of Newberry named as an additional insured on the policy; the successful bidder shall also maintain workers compensation and vehicle liability insurance in the amounts required by statutory law. Proof of such coverage will be provided upon demand or as otherwise provided in the bid specifications.
- 4. <u>CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION:</u> Questions or problems arising after award of this contract shall be directed to the Purchasing Director, P.O. Box 156, Newberry, SC 29108, or by calling 803-321-2100.
- 5. **FORCE MAJEURE:** The Contractor shall not be liable for any excess costs if the failure to perform the contract arises out of causes beyond the control and without fault or negligence of the contractor. Such causes may include, but are not restricted to acts of God or of a public enemy, acts of Government in either its sovereign or contractual capacity, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, freight embargoes, and unusually severe weather; but in every case the failure to perform must be beyond the control and without the fault or negligence of the contractor. If the failure to perform is caused by default of a subcontractor, and if such default arises out of causes beyond the control of both the contractor and subcontractor and without excess costs for failure to perform, unless the supplies or services to be furnished by the subcontractor were obtainable from other sources in sufficient time to permit the contractor to meet the required delivery schedule.
- 6. **PUBLIC RELEASE:** Contractor agrees not to refer to award of this contract in commercial advertising in such a manner as to state or imply that the products or services provided are endorsed or preferred by the User.

- 7. **QUALITY OF PRODUCT:** Unless otherwise indicated in this bid it is understood and agreed that any items offered or shipped on this bid shall be new, in first class condition, and without defect and that all containers shall be new and suitable for storage or shipment, and that prices include standard commercial packaging and shipping to the specified destination in Newberry County. No demonstration models shall be sold as new, without prior written permission of the County.
- 8. S.C. LAW CLAUSE: Upon award of a contract under this bid, the person, partnership, association or corporation to whom the award is made must comply with the laws of South Carolina and any other applicable local laws or ordinances which require such person or entity to be authorized and/or licensed to do business with this State. Notwithstanding the fact that applicable statutes may exempt or exclude the successful bidder from requirements that it be authorized and/or licensed to do business in this State, by submission of this signed bid, the bidder agrees to subject himself to the jurisdiction and process of the courts of the State of South Carolina as to all matters and disputes arising or to arise under the contract and the performance thereof, including any questions as to the liability for taxes, licenses, or fees levied by the State.
- 9. **ASSIGNMENT:** No contract or its Provisions may be assigned, sublet, or transferred without the prior written consent of the Purchasing Director.
- 10. **AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:** The successful bidder will take affirmative action in complying with all Federal and State requirements concerning fair employment of the handicapped, and concerning the treatment of all employees, without regard or discrimination by reason of race, color, religion, sex, national origin or physical handicap.
- 11. **<u>DELIVERIES:</u>** All deliveries shall be FOB Destination. It is agreed by the parties hereto that delivery by the contractor to the common carrier does not constitute delivery to the County. Any claim for loss or damage shall be between the contractor and the carrier.
- 12. <u>APPROPRIATE S.C. SALES TAX</u> shall be included as a line item in the bid unless other wise noted in the request from the County. The rate for Newberry County is 7%. For vehicle purchases, emergency service vehicles, fire trucks, heavy equipment or other items that require titles from the South Carolina Department of Transportation, sales taxes must be listed as a separate line item in the bid or on the bidder's schedule.
- 13. **PAYMENT TERMS:** Payment will be made accordingly, after each grinding is performed.
- 14. **RIGHT TO PROTEST**: With regard to any goods or services valued at over \$15,000 procured through sealed bid method only, any actual or prospective bidder, offerer, contractor, or subcontractor who is aggrieved in connection with the solicitation or award of a contract may protest to the Purchasing Director. The protest, setting forth the grievance, shall be submitted in writing within 10 days after the aggrieved person know or should have known of the facts giving rise thereto.
- 15. **BID BOND**: Bidders are required to submit with their bids a bid bond either in the form of a cashier's check or form a Surety Company in the amount of 5% of the total bid price. Bid Bonds will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders once the lowest most responsive, responsible bidder has been determined. The bid bond will be returned to

the successful bidder once it has fulfilled the entirety of the contract and/or delivery of the said purchased equipment has been accepted by the County. The bid bond for this work shall be in the amount of \$25,000.00 and submitted with the bid response, failure to do so will result in a non-responsive bid.

- 16. PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS: The chosen vendor will be required to submit to the County a payment bond in the amount of \$50,000.00 prior to before commencing with the work, if the vendor intends to sub-contract any of the work specified in this document. The bond will be issued from a surety company with an "A" minimum rating of performance as stated in the most current publication of Best Key Rating Guide, Property Liability.
- Compliance with The South Carolina Illegal Immigration Act: By submitting an 17. offer, Bidder certifies that it will comply with the applicable requirements of Title 8, Chapter 14 of the South Carolina code of Laws (originally enacted as Section 3 of The South Carolina Illegal Immigration act, 2008 S.C. Act No. 280) and agrees to provide upon request any documentation required to establish either: (a) the applicability of Title 8, Chapter 14 to Bidder and any subcontractor or sub-subcontractors; or (b) the compliance with Title 8, Chapter 14 by Bidder and any subcontractors or subsubcontractors. Pursuant to Section 8-14-60, "A person who knowingly makes or files any false, fictitious, or fraudulent document, statement, or report pursuant to this chapter is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, must be fined within the discretion of the court or imprisoned for not more than five years, or both". Bidder agrees to include in any contracts with its subcontractors language requiring the subcontractors to (a) comply with the applicable requirements of Title 8, Chapter 14, and (b) include in any contracts with the sub-subcontractors language requiring the sub-subcontract to comply with the applicable requirements of Title 8, Chapter 14.

Specifications for Debris-Grinding Services at Newberry County Transfer Station

Equipment needed to perform the work in a timely manner, the County is requiring at least the following:

- Bull Dozer (size Cat D-6 or bigger)
- 1 grinder (maximum 3" screen)
- 1 track hoe or other means of loading grinder
- Successful bidder will be required to transport the above equipment to the site location (11374 Hwy 34, Newberry) and provide a certificate of liability insurance of at least \$2 million minimum coverage, with Newberry County listed as a certificate holder and provide the County with proof of worker's compensation insurance.
- The mulch produced by grinding operation will be displaced on site. Billing shall be based on machine hours but includes the full cost of the operation.
- Successful bidder will coordinate with the Public Works Director, Michael Pisano to ensure that work is performed during acceptable hours. Bidder will also arrange for the equipment delivery through Public Works.
- The amount of debris that will be ground will depend solely on the amount of debris the public brings to the facility. It is expected that the grinding will need to be done quarterly; however, it will be at the discretion of the Public Works Director if it is more frequent.

The initial term will be for three (3) consecutive years.
