- 2. Unit prices will govern over extended prices unless otherwise stated in this bid invitation.
- 3. **PROHIBITION OF GRATUITIES:** South Carolina law and the Newberry County Purchasing Ordinance prohibit the giving of anything of value in return for favors or other preferential treatment in the purchasing process. Bidders should govern themselves accordingly.

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- 4. **BIDDERS QUALIFICATION:** Bidders must, upon request of the county, furnish satisfactory evidence of their ability to furnish products or services in accordance with the terms and conditions of these specifications. The County reserves the right to make the final determination as to the bidder's ability to provide the products or services requested herein. Bidder determined to be irresponsible bidders are not allowed to bid to provide the County goods or services.
- 5. <u>BIDDERS RESPONSIBILITY:</u> Each bidder shall fully acquaint himself with conditions relating to the scope and restrictions attending the execution of the work under the conditions of this bid. It is expected that this will sometimes require on-site observation. The failure or omission of a bidder to acquaint himself with existing conditions shall in no way relieve him of any obligation with respect to this bid or to the contract.
- 6. AWARD CRITERIA: The contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder(s) whose bid meets the requirements and criteria set forth in the Invitation for Bid. Award may be made to one or a multiple of bidders, whichever deems to be in the best interest of the County, or unless otherwise stated on the bidder's schedule.
- 7. **WAIVER:** The County reserves the right to waive any Instruction to Bidders, General or Special Provisions, General or Special Conditions, or specifications deviation if deemed to be in the best interest of the county.
- 8. <u>COMPETITION:</u> This solicitation is intended to promote competition. - 3. HOLD HARMLESS AND INSURANCE: The successful bidder shall indemnify and hold harmless the County of Newberry and all County officers, agents and employees against all suits or claims for personal injury or property damage resulting from, or arising from, the successful bidder's performance of the contract, as well as against any suits or claims of any character brought against the County or its agents or employees by reason of any claim of infringement of any patent, trade mark, trade dress, or copyright, including reimbursement to the County for all attorney's fees and court costs incurred by the County in defending itself or its agents or employees against any such claim or suit. Proof of such coverage will be provided upon demand or as otherwise provided in the bid specifications.

- 5. **FORCE MAJEURE:** The Contractor shall not be liable for any excess costs if the failure to perform the contract arises out of causes beyond the control and without fault or negligence of the contractor. Such causes may include, but are not restricted to acts of God or of a public enemy, acts of Government in either its sovereign or contractual capacity, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, freight embargoes, and unusually severe weather; but in every case the failure to perform must be beyond the control and without the fault or negligence of the contractor. If the failure to perform is caused by default of a subcontractor, and if such default arises out of causes beyond the

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control of both the contractor and subcontractor and without excess costs for failure to perform, unless the supplies or services to be furnished by the subcontractor were obtainable from other sources in sufficient time to permit the contractor to meet the required delivery schedule.

- 6. **PUBLIC RELEASE:** Contractor agrees not to refer to award of this contract in commercial advertising in such a manner as to state or imply that the products or services provided are endorsed or preferred by the User.
- 7. **QUALITY OF PRODUCT:** Unless otherwise indicated in this bid it is understood and agreed that any items offered or shipped on this bid shall be new, in first class condition, and without defect that all containers shall be new and suitable for storage or shipment, and that prices include standard commercial packaging and shipping to the specified destination in Newberry County. No demonstration models shall be sold as new, without prior written permission of the County.
- 8. S.C. LAW CLAUSE: Upon award of a contract under this bid, the person, partnership, association or corporation to whom the award is made must comply with the laws of South Carolina which require such person or entity to be authorized and/or licensed to do business with this State. Notwithstanding the fact that applicable statutes may exempt or exclude the successful bidder from requirements that it be authorized and/or licensed to do business in this State, by submission of this signed bid, the bidder agrees to subject himself to the jurisdiction and process of the courts of the State of South Carolina as to all matters and disputes arising or to arise under the contract and the performance thereof, including any questions as to the liability for taxes, licenses, or fees levied by the State.

- 12. APPROPRIATE S.C. SALES TAXES, FEES AND PERMITS shall be included in the Vendor's base bid. The South Carolina tax cap for vehicles is \$500.00 and shall be reflected in the final invoice.

- 13. **PAYMENT TERMS:** Payment will be made when all work is completed and accepted by Newberry County as meeting the specifications here within.
- 14. BID BOND: For each bid in excess of \$25,000.00 each bidder will submit with their bid a bond in the amount of 5% of the total price of the bid submitted. The bid bonds will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders once the county accepts the lowest most responsive bid. If the most responsive bidder fails to perform the responsibility of the bid within 10 days of the award, then the bid bond will be forfeited to the county as liquidated damages and the next lowest bidder will be awarded the bid. Bid bonds may be in the form of a surety, a cashier's check or an unconditional letter of credit in favor of Newberry County issued by a commercial bank in South Carolina.
- 15. <u>PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS:</u> The chosen vendor will be required to submit to the County both a performance bond and payment bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price before commencing with the work. Both bonds will be issued from a surety company with an "A" minimum rating of performance as stated in the most current publication of Best Key Rating Guide, Property Liability.
- 16. THESE SPECS ARE BASED AROUND THE FEDERAL SPECIFICATION KKK-A-1822F, AMD Standards 001 - 00 It is the intent of these specifications, and all requirements listed herein, to obtain bids on vehicles to meet the local needs of Newberry County EMS and to obtain bids that may be easily and completely evaluated on an equal and competitive basis.

Because of the wide variances in types, configurations, options and models available in the industry, the purpose of these specifications is to set a standard by which all proposals received may be evaluated, studied and compared equitably. Vendors are required to return one (1) copy of these specifications, correctly and completely furnishing all information requested and answering all questions attached. Any requested data literature, drawings, etc. and detailed written lists of exceptions taken must also be enclosed.

Since bids from a number of suppliers are anticipated and Newberry County EMS cannot be expected to be familiar with all various technical details of all vendor's products, the only adequate method of evaluation will be to compare in this format. Vendors are cautioned that failure to submit proposals in format specified herein will result in disqualification.

Any questions for clarifications, etc. should be directed in writing to the above, and responses will be furnished in writing to all prospective vendors.

Considerable time and effort have been invested to design these specifications to the specific needs of Newberry County EMS. Therefore, alternate bids and bids on demo unit bids will likely not be considered.

It is further understood that the vehicle described is for use by Newberry County EMS in the provision of emergency services.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE VEHICLE

1.0 Scope, Purpose and Classification

- 1.1 Scope: This specification covers the remounting and remanufacturing of a commercially produced, surface medical care vehicle, hereinafter referred to as ambulance or vehicle. A vehicle in compliance with this specification shall be defined as a standard ambulance. This vehicle shall be in accordance with the Ambulance Design Criteria of the National Highway Traffic Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation, Washington D.C. This bid specification is based on the latest Federal Ambulance Specification KKK-A-1822 as a guideline.
- 1.2 <u>Purpose:</u> The purpose of this document is to provide minimum specifications and test parameters for the remounting and remanufacturing of an emergency medical care vehicle that meets the needs and desires of this agency. It establishes essential criteria for the design, performance, equipment and appearance of the vehicle. The object is to provide a vehicle that is in accordance with nationally recognized guidelines. It is the intent to return the unit to a new or like new condition per the specification.
- 1.3 <u>Classifications:</u> This specification calls for the following type of vehicle. It is in accordance with KKK-A-1822.

 Type I Cab Chassis with modular ambulance body.

 Class 2 Two rear wheel driven (4x2)

 Configuration A (ALS) Elevating cot and squad bench (3.1.5.1)
- 1.4 <u>General:</u> This is an engineer, design, construct and deliver type specification and it is not the intention of this agency to write out vendors of similar or equal equipment of the types specified. It should be noted, however, that this specification is written around specific needs of this agency. With the intent to standardize certain components, therefore, in numerous places we have named specific brands of components. This has been done to establish a certain standard of quality. Other brands will only be accepted providing the vendor provides documentation in the bid that the particular brand offered meets or exceeds the quality of the actual brand called for in the specification.
- 1.5 <u>Materials:</u> The emergency medical care vehicle, chassis, ambulance body, equipment, devices, medical accessories and electronic equipment to be delivered under this contract shall be standard commercial products, which meet or exceed the requirements of this specification. The ambulance shall comply with all Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS), the Federal regulations applicable or specified for the year of manufacture. The chassis, components and optional items shall be as represented in the manufacturer's current technical data. Materials used in the construction shall be new and not less than the quality conforming to current engineering and manufacturing practices. Materials shall be free of defects and suitable for service intended.
- 1.6 <u>Manufacturing Ability:</u> It is the intent of these specifications that the Remanufacturer of these vehicles has the ability to remount and remanufacture a complete ambulance within their plant facility, except for the chassis. The Ambulance Remanufacturer must have significant experience in the remounting and remanufacturing modular ambulance bodies and have performed a minimum of 50 remounts in the last two years. In addition, the Bidder/manufacturer must include with this bid, proof of \$1,000,000.00 product liability coverage. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Remanufacturer must show proof of being in business for five (5) consecutive years as of the date of this Invitation for Bids (IFB)in said business. As further evidence of the Remanufacturer's ability to perform, the contractor shall submit a list of ten customers with similar type remanufactured remounts. The references shall also include the name of service, address, contact, and phone number. Further, the references listing shall include the names and contact numbers of all remounts performed by the bidding party for the last six (6) months. These customers shall be easily identified in the references as recent remounts. Newberry County EMS will sample all said references and obtain other references from the field and compile results.
