ADDENDUM ONE Request for Proposal No.: 2023-11 Debris Removal & Disposal Services

The following shall be incorporated as part of the solicitation.

- 1. Marine debris does not apply to Newberry County, we have two lakes and rivers that may be applicable to these services
- 2. It will be the consent of both parties for the subsequent years of renewal
- 3. If there are increases in price due to CPI, they will be allowable based on the regulations with FEMA standards. Mention of potential CPI increases need to be stated in the submittals
- 4. A separate pricing for debris management site shall be included in the response (separate page is acceptable)
- 5. The prevailing rate at the transfer station would be charged, but there would be no markup by the County when billing the Contractor. The County will be billed at direct cost, with no markup
- 6. The County bills by the ton, not by cubic yard at the transfer station and at the C&D landfill
- 7. Items 1-3 on the price proposal form are to be calculated by cubic yard for the respective miles from the locations listed
- 8. Performance and payment bonds will be activated at the time contract is executed due to an event
- 9. Item 14 on the proposal submittal form refers to the cost for final disposal to the C&D landfill
