- Newberry County reserves the right to reject any or all proposals. Any objections to the specifications/requirements as set forth should be filed in writing by the deadline to submit questions or clarifications.
- No faxed or e-mailed proposals will be accepted.
- Newberry County will evaluate all qualifying proposals. All requirements in this RFP should be satisfied to ensure that the proposal will qualify for consideration. Newberry County desires to receive proposals only from vendors who can demonstrate the specified qualifications set forth in this RFP. The failure of any submitting firm to demonstrate that its qualifications are consistent with the County's requirements and expectations will result in that firm's proposal being disqualified.
- The County shall not be liable for any expense incurred in connection with preparation of a response to this solicitation. Vendors should prepare a straightforward and concise description of their ability to meet the requirements of this document.
- All requested information should be provided in order for a Proposal to be considered responsive. However, any firm submitting information that is determined to be substantially inaccurate, misleading, exaggerated, or incorrect, shall, at the County's sole discretion, be disqualified from consideration.

- This request is NOT a Bid; therefore, any alternate solutions that meet or EXCEED the outlined minimum requirements may be submitted for consideration. Newberry County is interested in any and all details of other innovative and original ideas above and beyond those discussed in this Request for Proposals.
- All ideas that meet or exceed the minimum requirements will be considered.

- The chosen vendor shall be required to provide the County with a general liability (GL) policy, with Newberry County listed as an additional insured, along with proof of worker's compensation coverage, regardless of statutory requirements. The GL policy shall contain \$1,000,000.00 of coverage, per occurrence.

#### 1. Introduction and Purpose:

Newberry County is requesting proposals for emergency services to include testing of air cylinders throughout the County for the Fire and Rescue Departments. There are eleven fire departments and seven rescue squads.

## Scope of Work:

The scope of work shall include the required Hydro testing for various types of cylinders, air packs and SCUBA equipment. The following are approximate numbers of each piece of equipment:

- approximately 300 cylinders (2.2 or 4500); various types include aluminum, steel and composite.
- Coft SCUBA; approximately 12 cylinders that require visual inspection, stamped and stickered for SCUBA use,
- 6000 psi air cascade cylinders (approximately 35)
- Scott 2.2 or 4.5 Air packs (approximately 150)

## 2. Proposal Submission Requirements

Sealed Proposals are due no later than 3:00 PM on Tuesday, April 4, 2023. Emailed and faxed proposals will NOT be accepted. Submit proposals in writing to Crystal Waldrop CPPB, Purchasing Director, at 1309 College Street, PO Box 156, Newberry, SC 29108. On envelope exterior, indicate RFP # 2023-5; Air Supply Testing for Emergency Services Equipment. Late proposals will not be accepted. Proposals must be signed by an employee or owner of the company who is empowered to act on the company's behalf.

Proposals shall include at least three references of current and past performance.

## Proposers are to include a cost proposal for the following:

- 1. The cost to perform the required tests for each item listed above, including flow tests and Hydro testing
- 2. Cost associated with the pickup and return of cylinders, if not included in item #1.
- 3. Cost to rebuild or replace valves, if needed. Include any warranty information associated with the replacement.
  - Does your company offer onsite hydro and valve repair, if so include pricing
  - Does your company provide pickup and return of cylinders and any associated costs for this service, not included in the above pricing

The contract will be awarded in July 2023 and will be for an initial three (3) years, with the option to renew for two additional consecutive years.

## 3. Proposal Evaluations

All proposals deemed responsive to this solicitation, as determined in the sole discretion of Newberry County, will be evaluated based on the following categories, and in the proportions indicated:

1.	Company's Understanding of Scope	25%
2.	Documented Experience	25%
3.	References	25%
4.	Cost Proposal and Additional Fees	25%
